The sugar industry's *Impact on Sugar* State Training Program provides you with the skills, knowledge and confidence that will enable you to participate effectively at an individual, enterprise and industry level.

In the current complex and ever-changing environment, the sugar industry needs passionate people working together for a profitable future.
